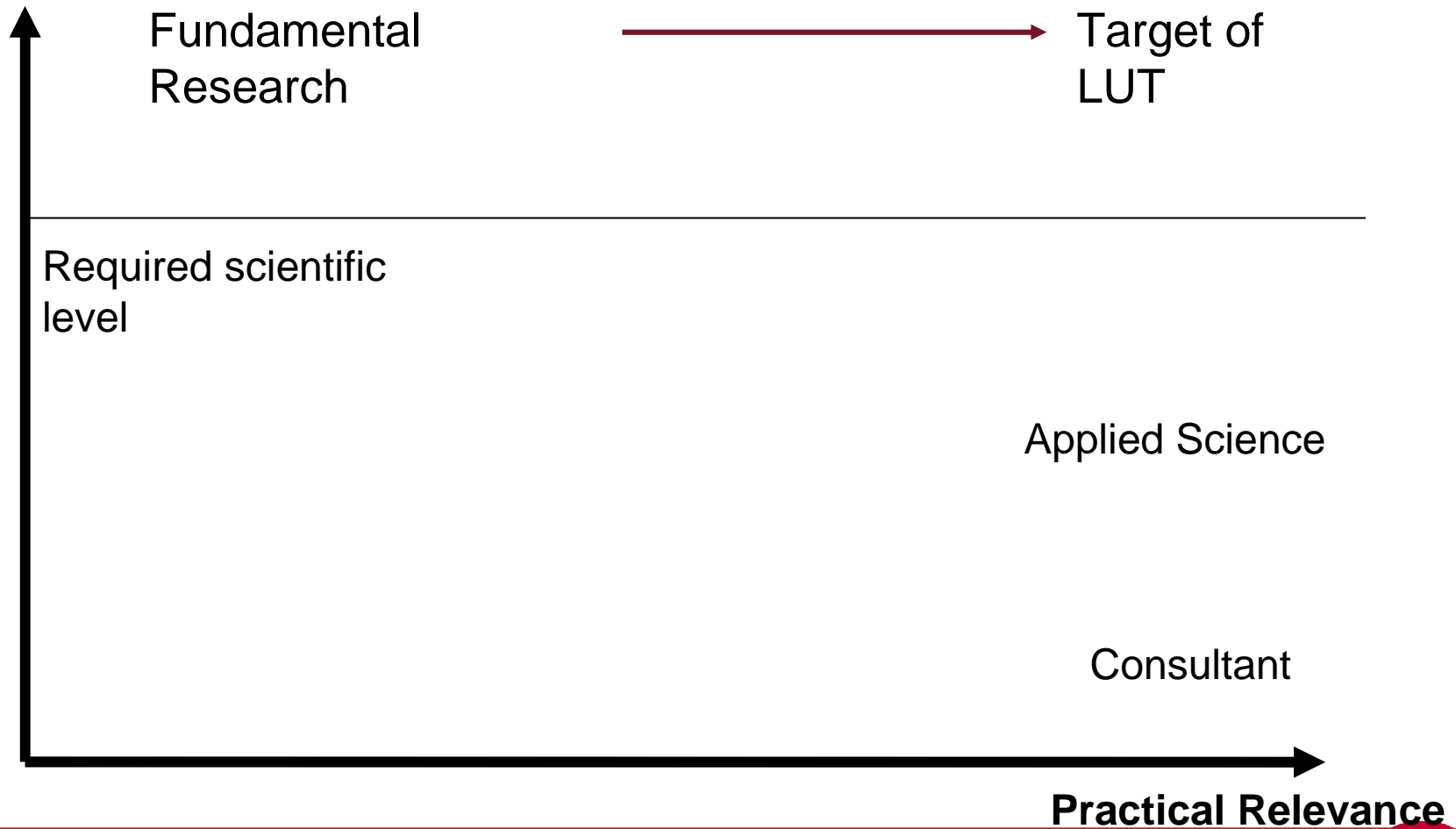
- We recruit the most talented and motivated people
